Ambassador High School partners with a local community college for the Early College Program. College professors teach on our campus for the first two periods of the school day. Early College is a program designed to provide students with a structured set of classes during the four years of high school to earn both a high school diploma and an Associate of Arts Degree by the time they graduate. When they move on to college they will have completed their AA Degree to save time and money for college! The community college courses offered at Ambassador High School will transfer to a California State University or University of California campus (CSU or UC) through the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC).
