

**Meal delivery program for our students (Effective March 17 – March 27, 2020)**  
**Information is as of March 16, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.**

Beginning March 17, 2020, Nutrition Services Department will package meal bags that have both breakfast and lunch meals in a bag to distribute at designated locations throughout the District. This program is available to anyone in the community who is 18 years of age or under, and all Adult Transition students are eligible participants. The student must be present to pick up a meal bag. All meals are free, even if the students are on paid status. Names or codes are not needed to distribute a meal bag. Meal pick-up time will be from 11:00 am – 12:00 pm.

Students from these schools may pick up a meal at any of the 16 locations that will be serving meals. Meals will not be served for the next two Fridays, since all schools will be closed. Students will pick up a meal bag with that has four meals included on Thursdays (Thursday lunch, Friday breakfast, Friday lunch, and Monday breakfast).
