Extra-Curricular Event Rules

2018-2019

Student attendance at extracurricular sporting events is encouraged. However, students must be reminded that these are school events and will be monitored. Even if students are not participating, they are still representing Canton ISD and are subject to CISD policy.

Students will be asked to correct behavior or dress code violations. If the student does not comply, he will be asked to leave and/ or will be subject to discipline based on the Students Code of Conduct the following school day. The Principal or designee has discretion in all matters.

- No running, chasing, playing tag, etc.
- No throwing of any objects including footballs, bottles, etc.
- No playing in and around the restrooms
- No pushing and shoving (roughhousing)
- No public displays of affection (PDA)
- Cheer for your team. No comments should be directed toward game officials, the opposing team or their fans.

Student Dress Code for Extra-Curricular Events (home or away)

- All Students:
 - No dog collars or spiked jewelry
 - No clothing with vulgar, rude or inappropriate pictures or slogans
 - No visible tattoos
- Guys:
 - No Piercings – ear, lip, nose
 - Shirts must be worn
 - No sagging pants
- Ladies:
 - Shirts and shorts must be modest – No exposed cleavage or midriff
 - No lip rings, nose rings or eyebrow rings
