Bayfield High School is a comprehensive 9-12 high school located in the heart of Bayfield, Colorado. The Town of Bayfield is located in La Plata County, in the southwest corner of Colorado at an elevation of 6900 feet in the beautiful Pine River Valley; with spectacular mountain and forest views in all directions. Bayfield School District has long been recognized as one of Colorado's finest and currently has one primary school serving 340 students, one intermediate school serving 330 students, one middle school serving 304 students and one high school serving 387 students. BHS is rated as a Performance School with the Colorado Department of Education and is dedicated to providing a safe and balanced atmosphere where students can develop the necessary skills to achieve and experience success as life-long learners and productive citizens of a global society.

### Highlights of the Academic Program

BHS is organized with yearlong classes averaging 65 minutes per day; this schedule was initiated in the 2016-2017 school year. There are eight credits available each year; half credits are awarded each semester. Seminar class, offered once per week, allows for all students to complete ICAP requirements, meet with teachers on an individual basis, and school culture/team building activities. Seminar is a Pass/Fail grade that does not impact GPA but does carry .25 credit per semester.

Concurrent Enrollment (early college) is available to all students in grades 11 and 12. On campus options are Honors English 3, AP Literature and Composition, Psychology, College Biology, Intermediate Algebra, and Public Speaking via partnerships with Fort Lewis College, San Juan College, Western State Colorado University and Southwest Colorado Community College.

Internships / Work Release courses are available to all students in grades 11 and 12 through established school-community partnerships with local businesses and organizations.

There are 5 AP courses offered at BHS: AP Language & Composition, AP Literature & Composition, AP Calculus AB, AP United States Government & Politics, and AP US History. Additional AP courses are available through accredited online providers. 55% of eligible students take AP courses.

The Language Arts department offers an Honors curriculum. 37% of students participate in the Honors curriculum.
