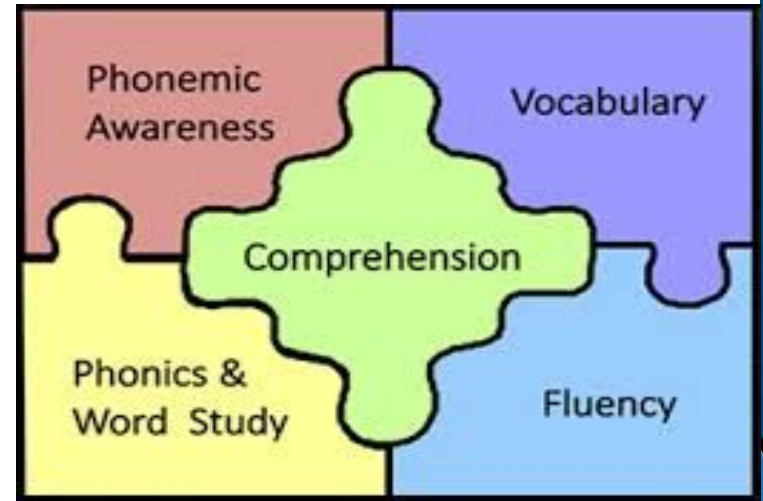

Academic Writing Program

ThinkCERCA is a flexible research based online tool that helps students engage in critical thinking activities.

ThinkCERCA provides personalized literacy through digital curriculum for teaching close reading and academic writing.

Prompts are provided that align with an individual student's reading level.

Student writing is assessed throughout the school year providing authentic measures of writing ability.





Middle School Math Program

75% of all our students will have the opportunity to master Algebra 1 before graduating from Faith Hope.

More students will be prepared to sit for the Loyola Academy Qualifying Exam or NTHS math placement exam

Honors Math will complete Algebra 1 and more

Grade Level Math will have the opportunity to complete Pre-algebra and Algebra 1 over three years of middle school



Learning Lab Team

Provides academic or social emotional support for approximately 25% of the Faith Hope Enrollment

Provides structured small group academic support for students with ICEPs or Accommodation Plans

Provides temporary support for students who demonstrate a minor deficiency

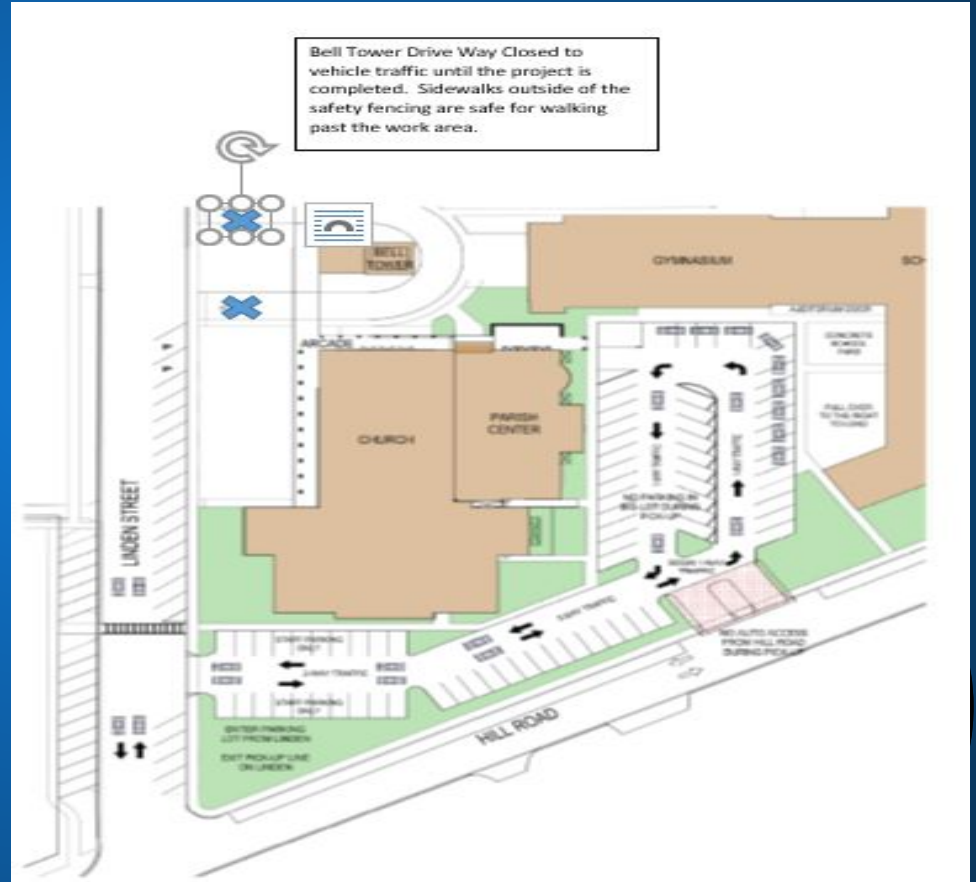
