What criteria are used to judge applicants?

- Major course of study
- Involvement in OHA or other habitat projects
- Extracurricular participation
- Leadership skills
- Community activities
- Awards
- Work Experience
- Photos showing them engaged in outdoor activities or community services.

How are scholarship funds dispersed?

The person selected to receive the scholarship will be presented a check at the OHA banquet on April 6, 2019.

Complete the application

Attend an interview by the selection committee
