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## **Tuition Assistance**

St. Finn Barr Catholic School offers financial assistance to qualified students and their families through the **BASIC Fund and Archdiocesan Scholarship Fund**. All applications are strictly confidential. Parents who wish to apply for the Archdiocesan Scholarship fund or for SFB Scholarship funds must complete a form for TADS online. BASIC Fund applications are available in the school office or online.

## **Parent Club**

St. Finn Barr Catholic School has two active parent groups that enhance the growth of the St. Finn Barr Catholic School spirit: the Executive Parent Board, and the Men's Club. The Parent Board coordinates fundraisers and volunteering for the school, supports parent-to-parent education, and fulfills other duties for the well being of the school. Room parent volunteers provide leadership to parents in each grade level and attend monthly meetings.

## **Code of Christian Conduct**

All families must abide by the code of Christian conduct and to all other school and Archdiocesan rules and regulations as explained in the Parent-Student handbook.

## **Fundraising for St. Finn Barr Catholic School**

*All participating parents pledged and must fulfill the obligations for each of the mandatory fundraisers or select the buy out option.*

- Walk a Thon (\$125 participate/\$175 buy out)
- Off to the Races (\$75 participate/\$175 buy out)
- Tuition raffle (\$125 participate/\$125 buy out)

A family may donate goods and services worth a maximum of \$100.00 to any fundraiser or to the school; this donation may count towards service hours according to the formula of one (1) hour for each \$10 donated with a maximum of \$100 per event. Minimum participation guidelines (including buyout options) are published by the Executive Parent Board at the start of each school year.

## **Service Hours**

Each participating family is obligated to provide 30 hours of service to St. Finn Barr Catholic School. Service allows the school to keep tuition costs low and encourages all families to participate in the life of the school. *If service requirements are not met, the family will be asked to pay the non-participating family rate for the following year.*

## How to Accumulate Parent Hours

All Participating Families are required to contribute 30 hours of volunteer time. **You may not buy out of service hours and/or donations.**

There are several events during the school year that cannot succeed without your active engagement and participation. Your Room Parents will contact you either by phone or email monthly with a list of events and a list of volunteer opportunities. They will also be communicating with you at the request of the Parent Board with periodic announcements.

The best way to volunteer is to reach out to your Room Parents and ask how to volunteer. It is essential that you know your Room Parents. They will be responsible for recording and filing your hours. Parents are encouraged to track their own hours in case of any discrepancies.

***A maximum of 10 hours per event may be earned toward required family hours.***

### **The YESs in Earning Parents Hours:**

- ✓ Purchasing items for general school use or for sports fundraisers/events,
  - one (1) hour earned for every \$10 spent on submitted receipt. Please keep your receipt(s) and send to the responsible Room Parent of your grade.
  - No more than 10 hours may be earned for monetary donations per event.
- ✓ Purchasing items for a specific school wide event and approved by the Event Coordinator.
  - **Monetary obligations for a Mandatory fundraising event do not qualify towards parent volunteer hours** – for example, \$125 paid for mandatory tuition raffle ticket do not qualify for hours toward your 30 parent hours.
- ✓ Volunteer with the Student Lunch program. Volunteers help in preparation and serving lunch to our children. This is a popular and much needed volunteer opportunity.
  - One (1) hours granted for each hour volunteered.

- ✓ Volunteer as a Coach in the Sports Program:



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- 30 hours are granted for being a Head Coach (one Head Coach per team).
- 15 hours are granted for being an Assistant Coach/ Scorekeeper (one Assistant Coach/Scorekeeper per team).
- ✓ Volunteer with the Sports Program fundraisers,
  - one (1) hour granted for every hour volunteered.
- ✓ Volunteer as a Room Parent or an Executive Parent Board member.
  - 30 hours are granted for each of these positions
  - 
  - Contact your Room Parent if you are interested in being involved at this high level of participation.
- ✓ Volunteer for the St. Finn Barr Church. The parish periodically holds events where volunteers are requested. The organizer of the event must notify the Room Parents of the parent who has volunteered.
  - one (1) hour granted for every hour volunteered.
- ✓ Members of your family may volunteer to fulfill your parent hours; however, parents are strongly encouraged to complete their own hours.

## **The NOs in earning volunteer hours:**

- ≠ No hours are granted for school supplies requested by teachers at the beginning of or during the school year.
- ≠ No hours are granted for participation in or donation to class parties and events.
- ≠ No hours are granted for volunteer chaperoning of specific classroom events.
- ≠ No “rollover” hours from one school year to the next.
- ≠ No family may not transfer their hours to another family.
- ≠ No hours are granted for volunteering at another Catholic Church or Catholic school.
- ≠ No hours are granted for monetary contributions meant for stewardship of the Church.



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An itemized list of hours, mandatory monetary obligations and any other parental commitments will be sent in February to each family.

Please do not wait until the end of the school year to fulfill your 30 hours obligation. If by year's end a family has not completed their required hours this information shall be forwarded to the Parent Board before end of the school year for determination of adding collection against family's FACTS account upon the administration's approval.

**DON'T WORRY!** Parents rarely have difficulty accumulating hours. All of these events and fundraisers are for your kids and most of the times involve your kids. We want your experience and your child's experience to be a positive one at St. Finn Barr and we are dedicated to making that happen.

## **Field Trip Chaperone/School Volunteer Procedures 2018-2019**

*Because parent volunteering is a fundamental part of our school functioning, all parents are required to complete the **Protecting God's Children** through the **Virtus website** at least once every three years.*

### **FACTS:**

- 1) All chaperones/volunteers must be over the age of 21 (Drivers must be 25) and must complete the *Protecting God's Children 3.0* Course online.
- 2) All overnight chaperones must clear a Live Scan fingerprinting (\$70, good forever)
- 3) Live scan registrations must be initiated by first registering through the Virtus Website.
- 4) For driving field trips, all drivers must submit a copy of a valid driver's license and insurance to the school office one week before the trip.

### How to complete the **Protecting God's Children 3.0 Course**:

- Go to: <http://www.virtus.org>
- Click on: First Time Registrant
- Under "Select Archdiocese" choose San Francisco
- Then create user ID and password
- Complete your profile information (name, address, etc.)
- Then select primary location "**St. Finn Barr Elementary**" (not Parish) then click continue
- Identify yourself as a "**volunteer**"
- Read and accept Archdiocese of San Francisco Policies and Procedures
- You will then be placed in the training course: *Protecting God's Children 3.0*
- The course will take approximately 45 minutes, and it is available in English and Spanish.

**For the Live Scan:** Take the form to a UPS office for fingerprinting. **If you are confirmed for a field trip or a new parent to the school, the school will reimburse you for 50% of the cost of the Live Scan.** The typical cost in its entirety is \$70. Bring a copy of the live scan form and your receipt to the school office.

\*\*\* If you anticipate chaperoning or volunteering at school events at all this year, it is a great idea to complete this program now. We thank you for contributing to a safe school environment! \*\*\*
