REGISTRATION

The registration form and a non-refundable deposit of \$100 is due at the time of registration and will be credited towards summer school tuition. The remainder of the tuition for summer school is due by July 20, 2020.

A late fee of \$75 will be charged to all registrations after June 12, 2020.

All summer school tuition must be paid in order to take final exams and receive credit.

BOOKS

Students are responsible for supplying their own textbooks.

ATTENDANCE

Students are required to attend 18 days of class in order to receive credit. Family vacations and doctor/dentist appointments are not sufficient reasons for absence. Please keep in mind habitual tardiness will result in the student being counted as absent (four tardies will equal 1 absence).

UNIFORMS/DRESS CODE

All St. Paul students must be in their St. Paul uniforms. Students enrolling from other Catholic schools will wear that school's uniforms. Students enrolling from a local public school will have a dress code provided by the Dean of Students.
