Congratulations, Class of 2019

St. Joseph Catholic School welcomed a new group of alumni Wednesday night when 65 seniors formally graduated.

Family and friends joined members of the Class of 2019 for two days of events starting Tuesday night with Baccalaureate Mass at St. Richard Catholic Church and ending with graduation the next night at Thalia Mara Hall.

The Class of 2019 had a lot to celebrate including these important facts:

■ Graduates as a whole completed more than 13,000 service hours throughout their career at St. Joe

including about 2,000 hours during their senior year alone.

■ The class received higher education scholarships totaling \$2.353 million dollars. Among the colleges and universities they will attend: Auburn University, Florida State University, Tulane University, Rhodes College, Millsaps College, Ole Miss, Mississippi State and Southern Miss.

On Thursday morning, just before the start of the final exam of the school year, members of the Class of 2020 claimed the Senior Deck between the 400 and 300 buildings with their first Senior Breakfast.
