IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS & TB RISK ASSESSMENT FORM **for KINDERGARTEN – 5TH GRADE FORM #7**

(Required prior to starting school)

A **Tuberculosis Risk Assessment** is required for all students entering kindergarten for the first time and for all students transferring from outside Santa Clara County and entering into grades one through twelve. This assessment must have been completed by a licensed health care professional within eighteen months prior to entering kindergarten, or within six months prior to entry into grades one through twelve.

Below are the health requirements for entrance into Kindergarten through Fifth Grade:

New students Entering **Kindergarten** need:

1. All immunizations listed below
2. Oral Health Exam by May 31, 2020
3. Physical Exam (prior to entering First Grade)

New students Entering **First Grade** need:

1. All immunizations listed below
2. Oral Health Exam by May 31, 2020
 - a. Documentation of previously completed exam **OR**
 - b. Documentation of new exam
3. Physical Exam (prior to entering First Grade)

REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS – Must Submit Official Immunization Documentation

- **Polio** (OPV and/or IPV) – 3-4 doses. Last one after 4th birthday.
- **DPT** (Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus) – 4-5 doses. Last one after 4th birthday.
- **MMR** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) – 2 doses
- **Hepatitis B** – 3 doses
- **Varicella** (Chicken Pox) – 2 doses
- **Tuberculosis** (TB) Risk Assessment - this must have been completed by a licensed health care provider within 18 months prior to entering Kindergarten or within 6 months for 1st grade students coming from outside of Santa Clara County.

Please have your doctor complete the attached TB Risk Assessment form and return it with updated required immunizations to the school office or District Office by August 5th prior to the new school year.
