Aloha students and parents:

On Friday, January 25th, we were informed that the construction company for our new performing arts auditorium would be bringing in offices in the form of trailers and that they would be using approximately 35-40 stalls for construction purposes.

This has made a huge impact on our student parking lot and will continue to affect parking and drop off for the next couple of years. Already the impact has been larger than what we foresaw and we are attempting to examine options.

In the meantime, until we have definite traffic patterns worked out, we are encouraging students to avoid driving to school if they have alternate transportation.

Students who use alternate transportation like bicycles and skateboards may utilize the provided racks to secure their items. We have moved the bike rack to I-Building and are procuring an additional bike rack. Skateboard racks are also available next to the registrar's office. Students are responsible for providing their own locks to secure their bike/skateboard.

We have been fortunate that student parking has been readily available, however, during different phases of this construction, parking will become extremely limited for our students.

Students may also utilize street parking if available. Students are not allowed to park in the teachers' parking lot.

I want to apologize for the inconvenience caused once again by construction in our student parking lot.
