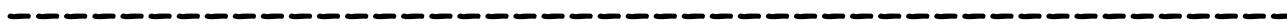
Behavior Management

- A proactive management system is essential for efficient teaching and learning. When students reflect on a hierarchy of development they are engaging in self-evaluation, which promotes internal motivation. Next are the levels of hierarchy students will learn.



Levels of Hierarchy

- Level D- Democracy – Does things because it is the right thing to do
- Level C – Cooperation – Cooperates, does what one is asked to do, works with others.



- Level B – Bossing – Bossy, bullying, bothers others, picks fights, teases, uses strength or threats to get what they want.
- Level A – Anarchy – Disrupting class, doing your own thing, not listening or cooperating.

Students who continue to work at a level A or B will need to fill out a reflection sheet to be signed and returned by their parent/guardian.

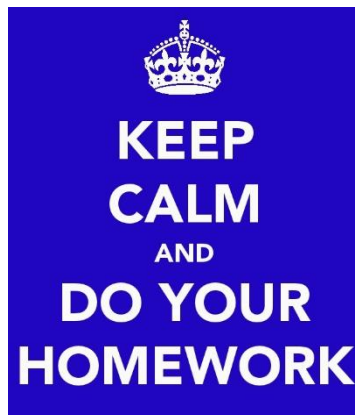

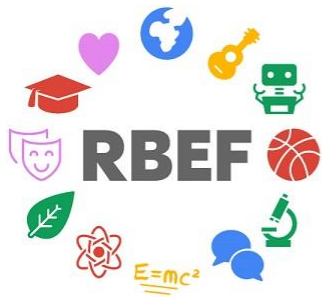


Chromebook

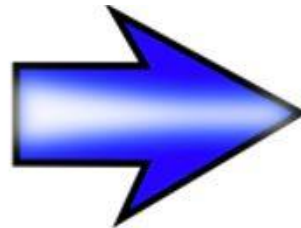
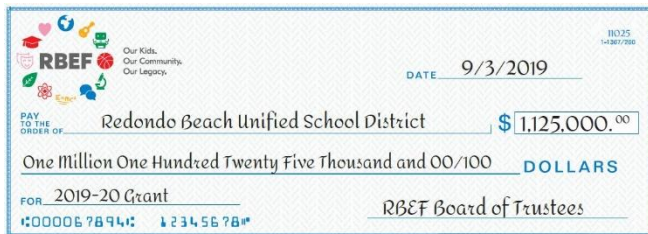
