



Independent Study Statement

Dimensions Charter School is an independent study charter school. As a student-based program, the focus is each individual student's abilities, learning styles, available resources, and goals. Our Educational Facilitators (EFs) partner with parents and students to develop and monitor a personalized learning plan.

The process for enrollment at Dimensions Charter School includes submitting a completed application packet. Once the admission paperwork has been processed, the parent will be contacted by an Educational Facilitator (EF) to set up an initial enrollment meeting in which a learning plan is developed based on the child's dispositions, preferred modalities, interests, talents, preferred environment, and current levels of development.

Dimensions Charter School Centers are not schools; they are one of several curricular options we offer to support a student's learning plan. Not all students thrive in a social learning environment, and we are not of the mindset that they must. Our aim is self-directed, independent learning. Dimensions Charter School works with parents and students forming a collaborative team to provide educational resources for all students. Working closely as a member of their child's educational team provides the opportunity for the parent to be closely involved with their child in the role of general education teacher at Dimensions Charter School. The parent accepts the role of planning lessons, providing instruction, evaluating progress, seeking and supporting educational opportunities, and modeling independent learning by learning alongside the student.

Our personalized approach to education is based on the following principles:

- Personalized objectives, methods of study, resources, and methods of evaluation
- Mastery – the desire and ability to continue improving
- Autonomy – able to self-direct
- Purpose – able to apply learning to bigger picture

While the parent is the primary mentor, students in our program are encouraged to have several mentors. Mentors can be family members, friends, specialized instructors, EFs, etc. The mentor's first objective is to prepare and organize the learning environment to meet the needs and interests of the child as well as promote independence. The mentor's ultimate goal is to intervene less as the student develops.

I understand that Dimensions Charter School is a public school of choice and feel the independent study approach and personalized learning is an appropriate placement for my child's skills and learning objectives. I will partner with an EF to develop and carry out a learning plan.
