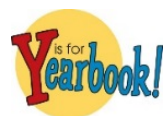

Parents – Reminder - Please Read & Follow our Attendance Procedure

Homework Requests – A Reminder

Requests for homework are handled through the office. If your student is absent for two consecutive days, you can call the office to ask that a homework request be given to the teachers. Teachers have 24 hours to process the request. If your student continues to be absent for more than two days, homework that was requested needs to be turned in before another request can be put through. **Please Note:** *If you are going on vacation and request homework before you leave, the homework is due upon the student's return.*
