Please read the following carefully and respond below:

- A copy of BBOE Policy ED regarding bus transportation and BCPS bus safety code of conduct is printed in the student planner. This policy explains that buses will only stop at designated stops and that a student may be allowed to ride a different bus than that to which he/she is assigned only in specific instances when the student presents a written request from the parent/ guardian in accordance with procedures devised at each school (see student planner for transportation procedures at BCMS).
- A copy of BBOE Policy JDA is printed in the student planner. This policy explains that corporal punishment is used as a disciplinary measure by school personnel for students unless a parent or guardian of a student notifies the school in writing that the student is NOT to receive corporal punishment. If you do not sign and return the letter from the principal to your child's homeroom teacher by August 15, 2018, your child will be subject to receiving corporal punishment under the terms of Policy JDA.
- A copy of BBOE Policy JS is printed in the student planner. This policy explains the Cell Phones and Other Personal Electronic Devices Purpose, General Statement of Policy, Responsible use at school, on buses or at school sponsored events, violations of the policy, Waiver of liability, and Supplementary Provisions. Furthermore, I understand that the district, school, and its employees are in no way responsible for any theft or damage of student's cell phones or electronic device while at school, on bus, or at school sponsored events. The school is not obligated to investigate any loss or damage of any cell phone or electronic device. Should a student's cell phone be confiscated, I understand that I may be required to come to the school to retrieve it. My signature indicates that I have been provided with, have read, and understand the new policy.
- Student Internet Usage Form. This form is located in your child's planner. Please read, check the appropriate box, and sign regarding permission to use the internet.
- Student Photo Release Form. This form is located in your child's planner. Please read and sign the form. Your signature is required in order for your child's photo to be used on our web site.
- Truancy Form: Georgia law requires children between the ages of 6-16 to attend school for the full session or sessions of school. Failure to comply with this law may result in students not earning promotion or being eligible to receive a driver's license. Please read and complete the form.
- G-Suite for Education (Google Apps for Education). This form is located in your child's planner. My signature indicates that I have been provided with, have read, and understand G-Suite for Education.
