### Students in Grades TK-2

Teachers in these grades will send out assignments through a learning packet that will include learning skills in the areas of English Language Arts and Mathematics.

Students will need to take the following textbooks home in order to access their assignments:

### Students in Grades 3-5

Teachers in these grades will send out assignments through a learning packet that will include learning skills in the areas of English Language Arts and Mathematics.

Students will need to take the following textbooks home in order to access their assignments:

Reading Writing Workshop

**Mathematics-** Coach Digital (these will be photocopied for our students)

### Students in Grades 6-8

Teachers in these grades will send out assignments through Google Classroom, textbook platforms, and teacher websites. Every student in grades 6-8 has a district issued personal learning device (Chromebook). In the case of an extended school dismissal/closure, our

teachers will continue to develop lessons and activities that can be accessed online using Google Classroom and additional resources while minimizing interruptions to student progress.

Students should use their district accounts to access their assignments in Google Classroom.
