GENERAL SUMMARY

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Depending upon the individual assignment, the Computer Operator / Programmer may perform all or a combination of the following:

- 8. Exhibit confidentiality, initiative, creativity and enthusiasm in performing job functions.
- 9. Perform related duties as required by the Manager of MIS.
