

## **Summer Program Code of Conduct 2019**

**Every student has the right**

- To attend summer programming without fear of being bullied, harassed, or abused.
- To participate without being distracted by the bad behavior of others.

**Parish staff and volunteers** will therefore use a variety of measures with any student

- Who uses aggressive, threatening, or offensive language or behavior.
- Who interrupts activities through persistently bad behavior.
- Who fails to respect other people's property.
- Who brings tobacco, alcohol, or drugs onto parish property.

**The consequences of bad behavior:**

- A student will first be given a verbal warning.
- If the student does not stop the behavior, a staff person or volunteer will walk over to the student and ask them to stop, giving them their second warning.
- If a student does not respond to the second warning, the staff person or volunteer will notify the Director who will then speak to the child and notify you, the parent or guardian.
- There will be a ZERO tolerance for drugs, alcohol, tobacco or weapons brought onto any campus. Parents will be notified immediately to come and pick up their child in the event that a child disregards this rule.
