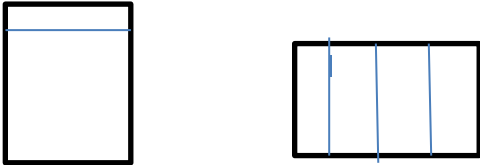


TK: April  
Lesson 6: book mark

**Prior to lesson:**

Cut strips of cardstock for book marks. In portrait position cut approximately 2 inches off of the top. Then turn paper to landscape position and cut every 3 inches.



**Supplies & Set up:**

Cardstock strip  
Colored pencils  
Pencils

**Introductions:**

Introduce yourself and your art team to the class.

**Visual:**

On the monitor show picture of stacking birds.

**Lesson:**

Demonstrate how to draw stacking birds.

(Demo drawing sheet attached)

With pencil lightly sketch the stacking birds.

After sketch is complete fill in the birds, grass and sky with color pencils.

Have the class write their name neatly on the back.

Art team print the year on the book mark.

**After the lesson:**

Art team will need to laminate the book marks.

Peel back one sheet of laminate apply the 3 or 4 book marks to sticky side.

Then cover the book marks with a top sheet of laminate with sticky side down. Gently rub the laminate sheets together with the book marks in between the sheets. Then cut around the book markers.

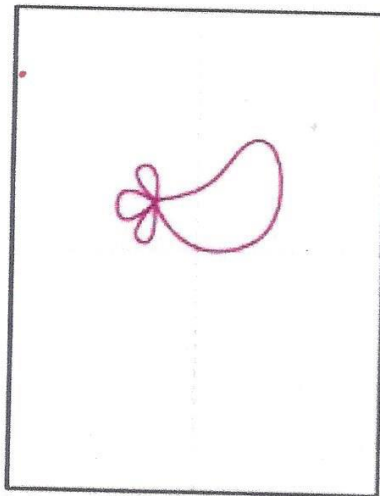
**Clean up:**

Place all of the art supplies back in the bin and return to art room.

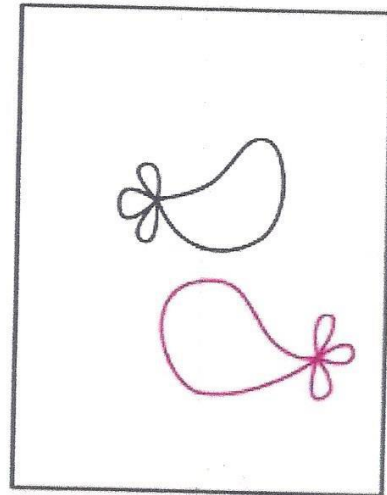
# Draw Stacked Birds



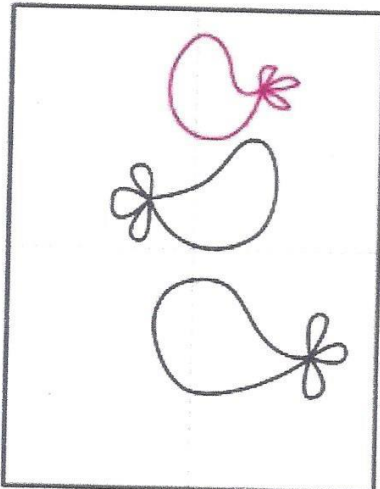
Supplies: Marker, Crayon.



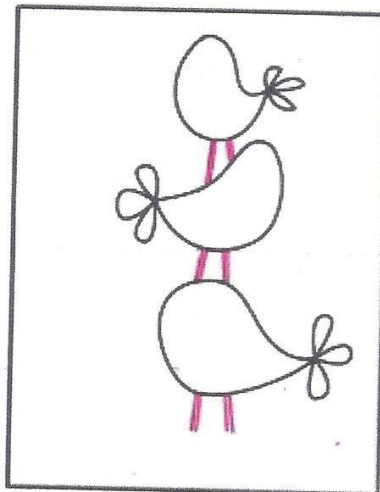
1. Draw guides. Draw middle bird.



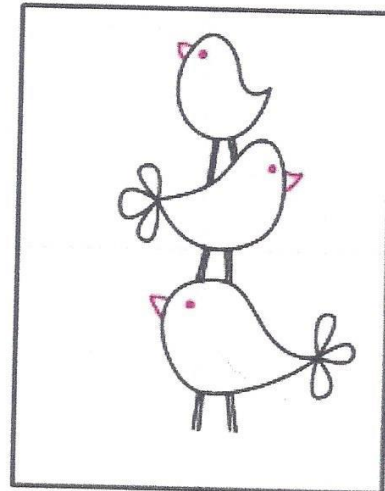
2. Add bottom bird body.



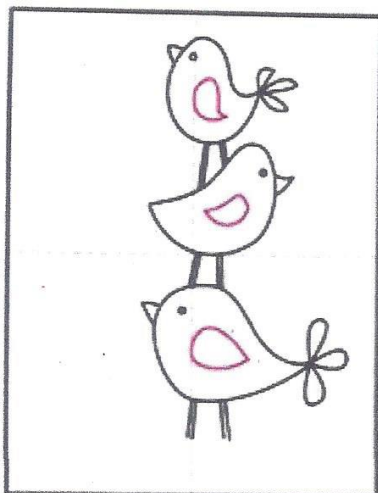
3. Add top bird body.



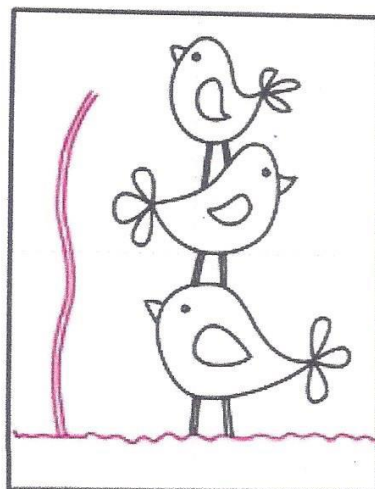
4. Add legs to each bird.



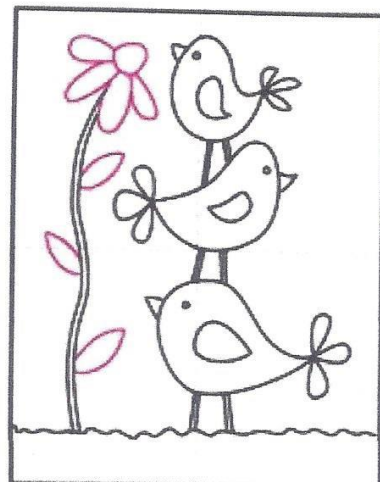
5. Draw beaks and eyes.



6. Add wings on each bird.



7. Draw ground and flower stem.



8. Finish flower and leaves.
