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STEAM Camp / Camp Invention

Students at Fennell Elementary recently had the opportunity in the summer STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) Camp / Camp Invention to design inventions that transformed the atmosphere, terrain, and ecosystem of an exoplanet. The students set up a Space Lab to hatch eggs and grow crystal trees, learned about the jobs of tomorrow, and explored beyond our galaxy (pictured on the right). Students also had the opportunity to experiment with computer science coding (pictures on the left). As well as providing a learning opportunity for students, STEAM Camp / Camp Invention was also a learning opportunity for teachers to become more knowledgeable about STEAM best practices, as well as how to implement those best practices in the classroom. Camp Invention was sponsored by the non-profit, National Inventors Hall



of Fame, and was funded in part by Math Science Partnership Program funds from the South Carolina State Department of Education and 21st Century Community Learning Center funds.
