FBI YOUTH LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

On July 27-29, 2020, and July 29-31, 2020, the Indianapolis Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the FBI Citizens Academy Alumni Association will host two sessions of the FBI Youth Leadership Academy (YLA). The YLA is designed to promote an educational experience that will provide students with valuable leadership training and a greater understanding of the FBI. Through interactive physical challenges and classroom discussions we seek to further explain to youth how the FBI addresses the concerns of the community. Utilizing FBI strategic planning techniques and exercises, participants will have the opportunity to hone their decision making and leadership skills.

To be considered, the candidate must:

- have completed their junior year, and not yet completed high school by 7/27/20;
- have a GPA of at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale);
- possess qualities of leadership, scholastic achievement and good citizenship;
- commit to attending the entire program; and
- write an essay of no more than 500 words depicting their interest in the program and how it will enhance their future plans.

Each session of this camp will be a two day, two-night residential event, and will be hosted at Bradford Woods, Indiana University's experiential learning center. Bradford Woods is located just south of Mooresville, on State Road 67. Its 2,500 acres are dedicated to the enrichment and education of youth and adults from all over the country. Students will be housed on site, and chaperoned by FBI personnel.

Session #1: Monday, July 27th at 9:00 a.m. - Wednesday, July 29th at 10:00 a.m.

Session #2: Wednesday, July 29th at 11:00 a.m. - Friday, July 31st at 10:00 a.m.

We would like the YLA to be comprised of top-notch students from a variety of high schools. Candidates must complete the attached application, which requires a signature from both a parent/guardian and the principal. Students should indicate the session dates they are available to attend on the application. Completed applications and essays should be mailed to: *Kathryn Sipes, Community Outreach Specialist, FBI Indianapolis, 8825 Nelson B. Klein Parkway, Indianapolis, IN 46250*. All applications must be received by **April 1, 2020**. Applications will be reviewed and 20 students will be selected to participate in each session.

Those selected will be invited to a one day FBI orientation session (optional) on **Tuesday, July 21st, 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**, to be hosted at the FBI Indianapolis Field Office, 8825 Nelson B. Klein Parkway. More details will be provided to participants at a later date.

Parents and/or guardians do not have to be present for the sessions. Students must arrange their own transportation. There is no cost for students to participate; lodging and all meals are included.

IMPORTANT INFO ABOUT SENIOR PICTURES FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

STARTING NEXT YEAR, INTER-STATE STUDIOS WILL BE THE EXCLUSIVE YEARBOOK PHOTOGRAPHER AND SENIORS WILL NO LONGER HAVE THE OPTION TO SUBMIT SENIOR PICTURES FOR THE YEARBOOK FROM AN OUTSIDE SOURCE. INTER-STATE STUDIOS WILL BE AT SHS ON **JULY 23, 2020** AND **JULY 24, 2020** TO TAKE FOUR CAP AND GOWN PICTURES AND FOUR STANDARD SCHOOL PICTURES. THE STUDENT CAN THEN CHOOSE WHICH PICTURE THEY PREFER TO BE PUBLISHED.

SELECTIVE SERVICE

All 18-year-old males are required by federal law to register with the Selective Service. Not registering for the Selective Service can severely impact finances, employment and services. Seniors can register for Selective

LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER

Our Resource officers will begin issuing a ticket for tobacco, electronic cigarette, or vape, a class C infraction; IC code: 35-46-1-10.5 (a) (3). The ticket will summons the student and a parent to Superior Court 2. The student will not be able to pre-pay for the ticket instead of coming to court. The Judge will issue a fine at court that has to be paid. The fine could reach \$500. Most likely, the first offense will be a \$160 fine. The prosecutor may offer the student an opportunity to complete a class in lieu of a ticket. The cost of that class is \$50. Students would only be allowed to attend this class one time.
