



Cell Phone and Technology Devices in the Classroom (Junior High School Students 6 - 8th grade)

PCHS recognizes the importance of communication, collaboration, and providing opportunities for students to be productive in the classroom with technology devices for educational purposes. To keep the focus on academics and to reduce unnecessary distractions, the school enforces the following:

- Cell phones shall be POWERED OFF and in the student locker, 8:00 a.m. - 3:05 p.m.
- Students should not access the phone during school hours.
- Students may not wear or use watches with internet or phone capabilities during school hours.
- Students may not use personal technology devices (laptops or tablets) during school hours.
- Chromebooks may be used in the classroom for educational purposes, and only when given direct instruction from the teacher for its approved use.
- Chromebooks should only be used in classrooms, the recreation room after school, and in the library.
- If students need to make or receive a phone call, they are to seek assistance from the office or a teacher.
- If a student does not follow these guidelines, as well as expectations in the Student Handbook (pg. 24-25), there will be consequences assigned by the Principal.
