- Provide homework assistance/ time 45 to 60 minutes 4 out of 5 days.

- Provide enrichment and supplementary activities in STEAM weekly to increase and interest in STEM related careers for students and parents.
- Goal 5:** To provide Healthy Living and Wellness Activities/Programs and offer Parent Involvement Workshops, Activities and Resources to the families of regular program attendees.
- Provide healthy living and physical fitness activities/ resources to support and enhance healthy living strategies three out of five days weekly.
 - Attendance goals for each site- 50% of allotted number of students will meet or exceed 30-day attendance threshold.
 - Offer educational and personal development activities/ resources/ programs to families of children participating in the 21st CCLC Programs. Each 21st CCLC site will provide/ conduct 3 to 5 parent involvement activities, workshops, and/or informational materials yearly.
