SEMESTER EXAM EXEMPTIONS

The THS Exam Exemption Policy is designed to reward students for good grades, near-perfect attendance, and good behavior throughout the school year. The following criteria were developed to encourage behaviors that lead to student success in high school and beyond. There are NO exceptions to the exemption criteria AND lost cards will not be replaced.

A student may qualify for an exam exemption meeting the following conditions:

- Have no fees, fines, or owed detention hours. These matters must be cleared up by:
 - Fall Semester: Wednesday, January 9, 2019
 - Spring Semester: Tuesday, May 14, 2019 (seniors)
Wednesday, May 22, 2019 (underclassmen)
- Absences, as well as averages, are counted by each class independently.
 - Students with a grade between 70 and 79 must have zero absences.
 - Students with a grade between 80 and 89 must have no more than one absence.
 - Students with a grade between 90 and 100 must have no more than two absences.
- Have no discipline referrals resulting in truancy, no more than one ISS assignment, and no ISS assignment more than three days, suspension, or removal to DAEP.

All absences count with the following exceptions:

- Absences covered by a doctor's note.
- College Day visits (TWO PER YEAR) with verification from the college.
- Religious Holidays
- Absences of up to two days for funerals of immediate family members.

Three tardies will count as one absence.

Semester averages will be calculated in the following way:

- 1st Semester (avg. of 1st & 2nd 6 Weeks Grades with 3rd 6 Weeks Progress Report)
- 2nd Semester (avg. of 4th & 5th 6 Weeks Grades with 6th 6 Weeks Progress Report)

Exam Exemptions are at teacher's discretion.
