Notice to Parent or Guardian for Emergency Administration of Unassigned Epinephrine Auto-Injectors


Dear Parent or Guardian,

In accordance with Chapter 38, Subchapter E of the Education Code, the Board of Mercedes Independent School District has adopted a policy, FFAC (Local), to allow authorized school personnel who may have been adequately trained to administer an unassigned epinephrine auto-injector to a person who is reasonably believed to be experiencing an anaphylactic reaction. Authorized and trained individuals may administer an epinephrine auto-injector at any time a person experiencing anaphylaxis on a school campus.

A sufficient number of school personnel and volunteers at each campus will be trained to administer epinephrine. At least one trained individual will be present on campus during regular school hours and whenever school personnel are physically on site for school sponsored activities.

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Aviso a Los Padres o Tutores Para Emergencias Administración de Auto-inyectores de Epinefrina no Asignados

Estimado padre o tutor:

De acuerdo con el Capítulo 38, Subcapítulo E del Código de Educación, la Mesa Directiva del Distrito Escolar Independiente de Mercedes ha adoptado una póliza, FFAC (Local), para permitir que el personal escolar y/o voluntarios de la escuela autorizados que han sido adecuadamente capacitados para administrar un auto-inyector de epinefrina no asignado a una persona que se cree razonablemente que está experimentando una reacción anafiláctica. Las personas autorizadas y capacitadas pueden administrar un auto-inyector de epinefrina en cualquier momento a una persona que experimenta anafilaxia en una escuela.

El Distrito se asegurará de que en cada escuela se capacite a un número suficiente de personal escolar para administrar epinefrina de modo que al menos una persona capacitada esté presente en la escuela durante las horas escolares regulares y también que el personal escolar esté presente par alas actividades patrocinadas por la escuela durante horas fuera del día escolar.
