COCISD School Board approves funds for security

The COCISD Board of Trustees voted to approve increased security funding on Monday, Feb. 26th, which allows for the placement of trained, armed police officers at each campus.

In a letter sent home to COCISD parents and guardians last week, Superintendent Dr. Leland Moore explained that reviews of the district safety and security plans had been completed by administrators and the COCISD Police Department.

“Based on these reviews, changes are underway in order to increase the safety and security of our dis-

trict,” said Dr. Moore. These updates will affect all campuses.”

A complete security study and district safety protocol report will be presented to the Board on March 26th.
