Dear Parents/Guardians:

Again this year, the **Middle College Program** will be offered to students enrolled in the courses listed below. In partnership with Fairleigh Dickinson University (FDU), Bordentown Regional High School (BRHS) is offering a program that will allow your son/daughter to earn college credits for courses taken at BRHS.

BRHS teaching faculty will teach the approved courses during the regular school day. The courses are as follows:

Creative Writing
Chemistry I
Chemistry II-Honors

AP Calculus
AP US History
Genocide

AP English
Physics II-Honors
Spanish V

A student participating in the Middle College Program will receive a course grade from BRHS on our report card and from Fairleigh Dickinson University on their official transcript. In order to receive credit from FDU, a grade of a "C" or better must be achieved in the class. Each course in the program is three college credits. If your son/daughter attends FDU upon graduation from BRHS, these credits are automatically transferred to your child. If your son/daughter attends another college, these credits are eligible for transfer to over four hundred universities and colleges as regular FDU credits. If your son/daughter is scheduled for any course in the Middle College Program and does not wish to participate in the program, he/she will receive a grade only from BRHS. All students participating in the program will receive a Fairleigh Dickinson University Student I.D. card allowing computer and library privileges to all FDU libraries.

Your son/daughter will be able to register for the **Middle College Program** courses that are being offered this semester in which he/she is enrolled. Registration can now be done online at www.fdu.edu/middle
The Registration Portal will close on September 22, 2019. The cost for each course is \$267.00.


