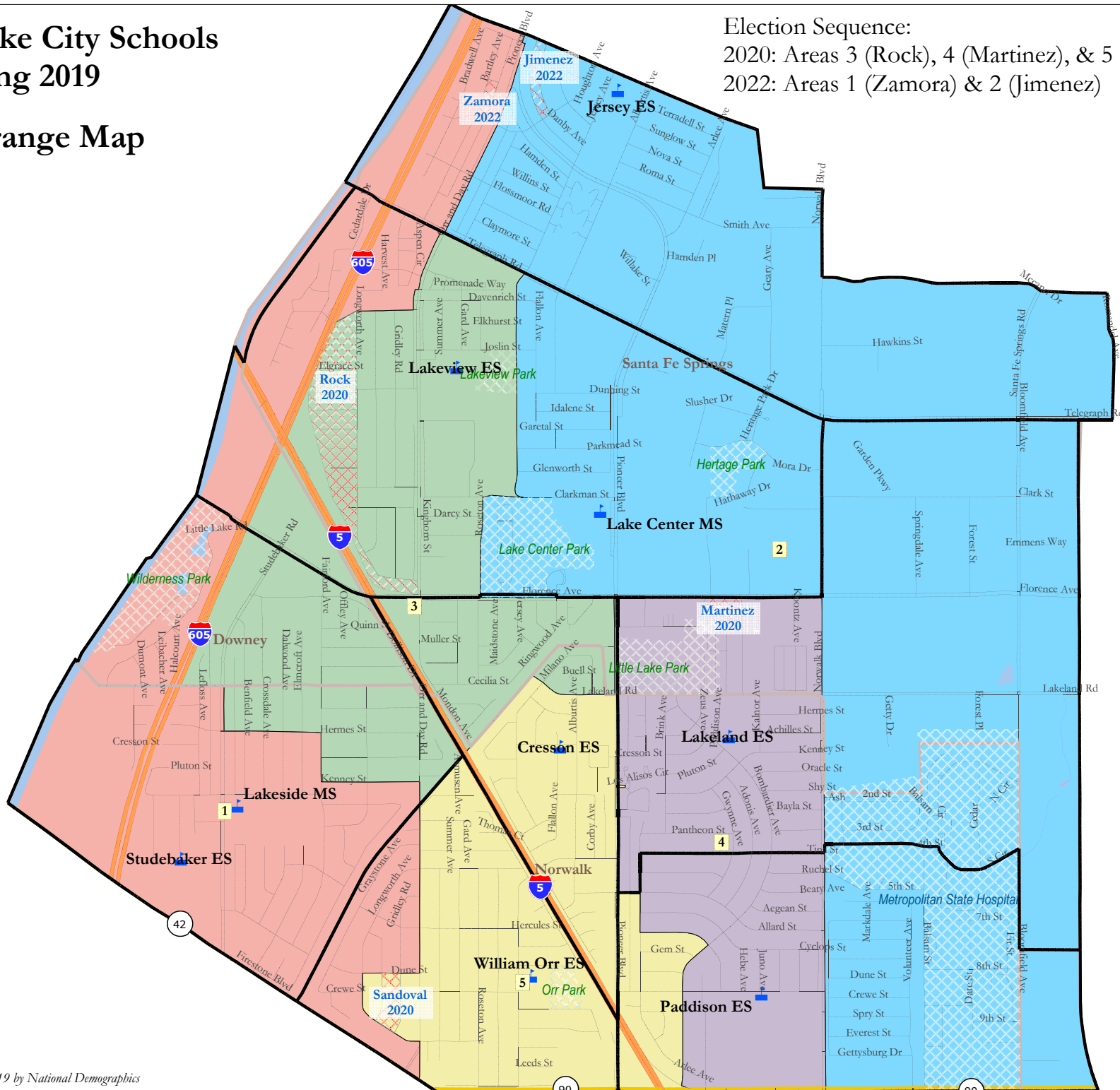


Little Lake City Schools Districting 2019
