TN Early Postsecondary Opportunities



Tennessee students have an unprecedented opportunity for education and training beyond high school through the [TN Promise](#). To ensure students are ready to take full advantage of the TN Promise and succeed in postsecondary, all students should have access to rigorous and relevant early postsecondary opportunities (EPSOs). **Research has shown that students who participate in early postsecondary courses are more likely to enroll and persist in postsecondary.**

Accountability Model and TN Ready Graduate

Measure of School Quality and Student Success

- **Ready Graduate indicator** (for high schools)

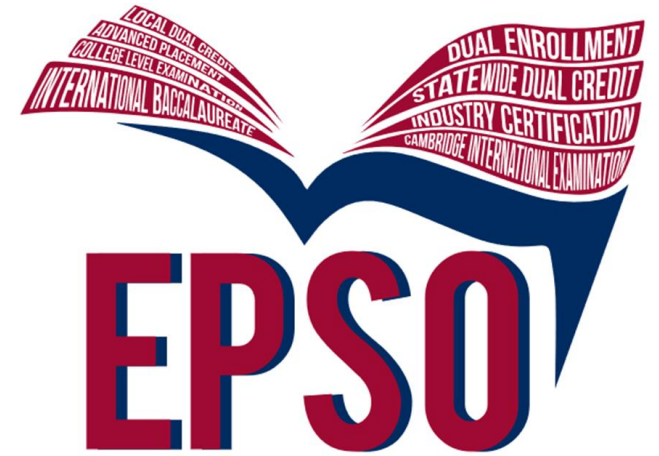
Graduation Rate multiplied by the percentage of students who are **Ready Graduates**. A Ready Graduate meets one of the following criteria (students can only be “counted” once):

1. scoring **21 or higher on ACT** OR
2. completing **4 EPSOs** OR
3. completing **2 EPSOs + earning industry certification** (on a CTE pathway leading to a credential) OR
4. completing **2 EPSO + designated score TBD on ASVAB AFQT**

*This metric defines four “checks” for evidence that graduates have **demonstrated** postsecondary and workforce readiness.*

Early postsecondary opportunities allow students to:

- earn postsecondary credits while in high school
- become familiar with postsecondary expectations
- develop confidence and skills for success in postsecondary
- make informed postsecondary and career decisions
- decrease the time and cost of completing a certificate or degree



GHS Advanced Placement

266 enrollments in AP courses at GHS

64% scored 3 or above for 3+ hours of college credit

When compared to international averages, GHS average AP pass rate ranks **14** percentage points higher than the international average.

GHS Dual Enrollment

248 enrollments

At GHS,
