

Zoom- Trinity Hall uses Zoom as a web conferencing system to gather as a community and deliver instruction virtually. The online platform allows all members of the community to host a meeting and work collaboratively from home. All students and faculty can sign in with their Zoom account for classes, community meetings, class meetings, athletic workshops and clubs. Schoology- Schoology is the Learning Management System (LMS) used by Trinity Hall. Each course has a schoology page where faculty members can post assignments, give assessments, and create discussion boards. Students submit all assignments through Schoology. In addition, resources are posted on a variety of group pages such as the Student Council group, SCOPE, Parents Association, Faculty Learning Community and the newly created Student and Parent Resources for Remote Learning. Directions on how to join these groups as a parent or student were sent in the Community Notes.

VoiceThread- VoiceThread is an online platform where students can create and collaborate on content online. Teachers can post slideshows and ask students to record comments, answer questions, or add content. Each student and faculty member have an individual account. Albert - Albert is a web based review and assessment tool. All students at Trinity Hall have an individual Albert.io account. Students may be assigned work by teachers to help review content and assess levels of understanding. In addition to individual course work, students are able to access practice for the SAT and ACT on the Albert site.
