\*WAC 392-137-115 Student residence – Definition. As used in this chapter, the term “student residence” means the physical location of a student’s principal abode – i.e., the home, house, apartment, facility, structure, or location, etc. – where the student lives the **majority** of the time.

\*\*RCW 28A.600.200 and Washington Interscholastic Activities Association (WIAA), Section 18.10.0 Residence defines student’s residence for interscholastic contest eligibility as the place where the family unit has established its home and/or the place where the student is habitually present and to which, when departing, the student intends to return. The family unit is defined as adult(s) who has/have had legal custody or legal guardianship of the student for at least one (1) year and with whom the student resides.
