## Smithville ISD Announces Pre-Kindergarten Registration

For the 2019-2020 School Year.

Tuesday, August 6, 2019, 8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

The Smithville Independent School District is offering a Pre-Kindergarten Program for children who will be four years of age on or before September 1, 2019. In order to be eligible for the Smithville ISD Pre-Kindergarten Program, you must qualify by one or more of the following criteria:

1. Unable to speak or comprehend the English language.
2. Economically disadvantaged
3. Homeless, as defined by federal law, regardless of the residence of the child, or either parent or child of the child's guardian or other person having lawful control.
4. Parent is an active member of military force (excluding Reserves) or has been hurt/killed in military assignment.
5. Have ever been in the conservatorship (foster care) of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following an adversary hearing. You must bring the letter that DFPS sends you by mail.
6. Parent is eligible for the Star of Texas Award as follows:
  - a. a peace officer under Section 3106.002, Government Code; or
  - b. a firefighter under Section 3106.003, Government Code; or
  - c. an emergency medical first responder under Section 3106.004, Government Code.

Pre-K Registration will be held at Brown Primary, 403 SW 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Smithville, Texas. The hours of registration will be from 8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m., Tuesday, August 6, 2019.

Please bring a copy of the child's original birth certificate, copy of current shot record, copy of social security card, and guardianship papers (if residing with someone other than a parent). You will also need to show proof of residency (water bill, electric bill, lease/rental agreement, voter's registration card, cable bill, etc.).

If qualifying by:

- a) language, bring your child for testing
- b) income, bring proof of income (pay stubs with GROSS income of all working persons in the household, SNAP benefits eligibility letter, IRS forms, etc.)
- c) Texas Department of Family and Protective Services, a letter of verification must be provided.
