

# Authorities: Ex-school finance official stole credit card points

A Naperville woman has been charged with stealing more than \$11,000 worth of My Bank ... My Rewards credit card points from her former employer, Addison

Elementary District 4.

DuPage County Judge Joseph Bugos issued a \$10,000 arrest warrant on Oct. 25 for Marcia Boyan, 50, of the 2000 block of Oak Court. Boyan turned herself in to the DuPage jail on Wednesday afternoon, posted bail and was

released.

Boyan, who most recently was Naperville Unit District 203's chief finance officer until she resigned before this school year, is charged with theft of governmental property in excess of \$10,000, theft in excess of \$10,000, and two

counts of official misconduct.

Prosecutors say Boyan was assistant superintendent for business of District 4 between February 2016 and April 2017 when she stole for personal use more than 900,000 credit card points earned on the district's credit cards.
