- Black History Month

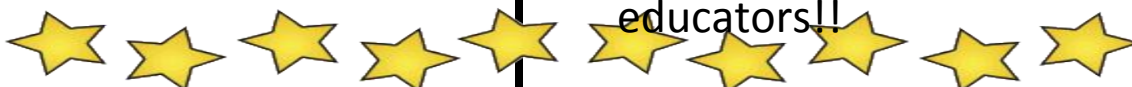
Writing
