



MBMS Daily Bulletin: Tues, Aug. 28th

- **NEW STUDENTS to MBMS!** Welcome to our amazing school. WEB stands for Where Everybody Belongs and the MBMS WEB Leaders would like to meet you, share some things and show you around a bit. Look for a call slip during your 5th period class this week and come to the quad stage at 12:25 on Thursday. See you then!
- If you have received a **Class Schedule that is problematic**, please fill out a Student Request for Assistance form in the office. If you are missing a core class, if you are missing a period, if you have two identical classes listed twice during the day, or if you were selected for an elective and it is not showing up on your schedule. Once your counselor is able to make the requested changes, **you will be notified**. Until you are notified, continue going to the classes listed on the schedule you received today.
- The **MBMS Library** is now open on a normal schedule. Please check the main Library doors for signs about hours of operation. As a reminder, the Library is open during Nutrition for Tech assistance and printing. A few quiet study spots are available. During Lunch, a limited number of passes will be handed out at the door to allow students to enter. The Library follows a 'silent study' model at lunch, which means the room is to be used only for study, reading, printer use and tech help. You may not use your cell phones in the room. If you are talking, disruptive, or behaving badly you will be asked to leave. No food, gum, snacks, or drinks are allowed in the Library at any time.
- **Attention:** New for this year, we are having a class President and Vice – President for each grade, 6th 7th and 8th. Students interested please stop by **room 105** for more information!
- **Picture Day is today.** Your elective class will take you over to take the pictures. Order forms are available online and in the front office. Until then, use your class schedule as your ticket for buying food at nutrition or lunch. 7th & 8th graders, you may pick it up in the office during nutrition or lunch. You can also still use your old student ID cards from last year if you still have it. You may no longer use a photo of your ID to buy food at school.
- If your parents have not yet **ordered your PE clothes** please tell them to do so **online** as soon as possible. The front office will not have any PE clothes to sell until Thursday, Aug. 30th.

- If you would like to have an **MBMS planner**, you may buy one for \$10.00 in the front office.
- **Dress Code:** We will begin enforcing the dress code next Monday. Please review the student handbook to make sure you follow proper procedures.
- **During nutrition and lunch:** Form only one line in front of the cart you wish to order from. Please have your ID card or schedule ready (Do not try to use your number.) Do not let any other student use your card. You may not use a photo of your card to buy food.
- The front lawn is reserved for lawn chairs only. Save your tickets – more information to come!
- **Cross Country** will start soon. If you would like to join, it will meet on **Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:15-4:15** starting **September 4th**. Meet on the PE **basketball courts**. No experience necessary, all levels of runners welcome.
