The evening will be jam-packed with exhibits, displays, and other artifacts of success which demonstrate that our students are well on their way to being college and career-ready.

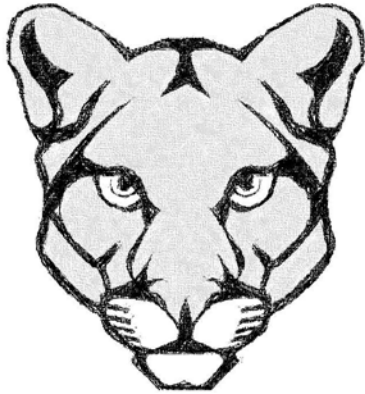
Tri County Shopper feature. If you receive the Tri County Shopper in your mail, look for a feature on the boys' basketball team!
