Aloha Nānākuli/Wai'anae Families of our Public and Charter Schools,

We hope this message finds you and your 'ohana well during this COVID-19 emergency in Hawai'i. We realize that the necessary closure of our school will cause a disruption to more than just our educational services. In order to help lessen the impact of this disruption, the school cafeterias at Wai'anae High, Wai'anae Intermediate, Mā'ili Elementary, Nānākuli High and Intermediate and Nānāikapono Elementary will be providing prepared breakfasts and lunches for all of our children via a "drive-thru" pick up system. This meal service will begin on Wednesday, March 25, 2020, and is projected to last through the school closure period. However, in observance of Prince Kūhiō Day, meals will not be served on Thursday, March 26, 2020.

Here are some details of the "drive-thru" pick up system:

- Breakfast and lunch will be provided Monday through Friday for any student on the coast, 18 years and under.
- Breakfast will be served from 7:30 am to 8:00 am..
- Lunch will be served from 11:30 am to 12:00 pm..
- One meal per child will be distributed and the child/children must be present in the car to be served a meal based on federal guidelines.

If you have any questions, please feel free to obtain further information on the school websites. We will continue to put the wellbeing of our children and families as a priority in all decisions made during this time.
