### SHARE YOUR TIME AND YOUR FAITH



### SACRIFICE WHAT YOU TREASURE



Generosity begins when we give from what you have, not from what you have left over. Sacrifice literally means to "make a sacred gift" of what you hold dear. Being a disciple means sacrifice – being generous even when you least feel like it, when you least can afford to do it, and when the person in need of your gift is the last person you wish to serve! You can make a sacred gift of time when you assist with household tasks instead of hanging out with friends, or skip a day at the beach to help with the garage sale at All Saints. A decision to donate a percentage of money gifted to you for a birthday or give part of your allowance or paycheck to the church each week are sacrifices that will grow into a lifelong habit of generosity. Challenge yourself to make a new commitment to sacrifice this year.



## LITURGY

### LITURGICAL MINISTRIES

#### ALTAR SERVERS **Grade 5+**

Young All Saints parishioners, Grade 5 and older who have received their First Communion, are invited to become Altar Servers. Altar Servers assist the priest and deacon during Mass and are an important part of making Mass a more reverent and prayerful experience.

#### GREETERS (with your family/adult)

Greeters welcome everyone who comes through the doors for Mass on the weekends. Effective greeters are cheerful, love people and are comfortable talking with strangers.

#### USHERS (with your family/adult)

Ushers create a welcoming environment at Mass and see to certain tasks that facilitate the flow of the Mass. They organize the collection and help make Mass reverent and prayerful, as they facilitate the Communion procession.

### MUSIC MINISTRIES

#### YOUNG VOICES CHOIR (2ND-7TH GRADE)

Do you love to sing? Join Young Voices to experience the JOY of singing the beautiful music of our Catholic faith at Mass.

Singing in choir lets us use our gifts to glorify God, lead the congregation in prayer, and expand our musical skills.

### Serving Your Community

#### CHRISTMAS OUTREACH

During the Advent/Christmas season, All Saints participates in service projects to assist our neighbors in need. We have need for many young volunteers to help wrap and prepare gifts during the course of the project.

#### HARVEST FOOD DRIVE

The HARVEST is All Saints' monthly collection of non-perishable food and other items in support of our local food shelves. HARVEST bins are out on the weekend of the first Sunday of the month.

#### SUPER SATURDAY SERVICE DAYS [SSSD]

Our goal is to broaden our parish's involvement in the larger community, especially for our youth. On at least one Saturday of each month parishioners of All Saints host an opportunity to help in the community. Some opportunities will be held at All Saints, others offsite.

#### GARDENS

If you don't mind getting your hands dirty and your feet wet, we have need for weeding, watering, and deadheading flowers. Why not Adopt-A-Garden as a family or another group?

### Caring for your Community

Prayer Shawls are created to be a comfort to persons suffering from mental, physical or emotional difficulties. Those who create these prayer shawls give their time and service as an act of prayer for the ones who will use the shawls.

They pray for healing, peace and knowledge of God's loving presence.

The shawls are then blessed by a priest and distributed.
