

Addendum to the CYO Athletic Code of Conduct

Thank you for volunteering to coach the students of St. Elizabeth School. As a school community we are thankful for your service and for serving as a role model for our children.

In addition to rules provided by the CYO listed on the code of conduct and in the manual, please see the bulleted items below. Thank you.

Coaches

Please refer to the Student Handbook for the rules established by St. Elizabeth School. The rules include the following:

- A student who is absent from school may not participate in any practices or games.
- A student who is suspended either in school, or out of school may not participate in practices or games during the duration of the suspension.
- A student who is injured must provide a letter of clearance before resuming play.
- A student who does not have the appropriate physical forms is restricted from practice and play.
- To remain eligible for play, a student must have achieved the academic requirements. Coaches will be notified by the administration if a student is ineligible due to academics.
- No one under the age of 21 may sit on the bench to assist in coaching. This includes siblings of players who are not on the team roster.
- Profanity is never acceptable!
- Student players must be treated with respect, especially from spectators.
- Parent spectators who are disrespectful to players, coaches or referees shall be reported to the Principal as soon as is possible.
