**Appeal Letters for Exemptions from Finals are due no later than Monday, May 20th at noon.** The letter must be written by the student for it to be accepted for committee review.

How many finals can you exempt if you meet the criteria.

Seniors – all classes if all fines are cleared.

Juniors – all classes if all fines are cleared.

Sophomores –3 core classes for the Spring semester if all fines are cleared.

Freshman –2 core classes for the Spring semester if all fines are cleared.

## Exemption Criteria

- 90 or above semester average – three or fewer absences in the individual class
- 80 to 89 semester average – two or fewer absences in the individual class
- 75 to 79 semester average – one or fewer absences in the individual class
- 70 to 74 semester average – no absences in the individual class
- no failing six weeks average per class for the entire academic year
- completion of all requirements of the class (all assignments turned in)
- all fines and fees paid prior to exam
- must not have been truant in that class
- no disciplinary infractions resulting in the following: ISS, OSS, DAEP
- No outstanding detention hours

**All library books are due May 17.** You cannot be exempt from finals if you owe the library a fine or a book. Also, if you owe Technology items, you cannot be exempt. Please clear this as soon as possible. If you have any questions, come see Mrs. Kammerer in the library.
