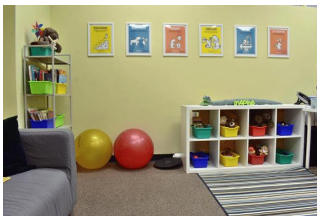
## From the Health Room
