

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

There are many ways that you can help promote and improve your child's educational experience here at Kilauea School. You can help with special events that we have scheduled throughout the year and/or make a commitment of once-a-week or even once-a-month as your schedule permits. Here's a few ways you could help:

LUNCHROOM/PLAYGROUND SUPERVISION-Daily from 10:50-12n, we need help both in the lunchroom and outside on the playground and basketball court areas supervising students during lunch/recess. You could sign up for one day a week or just once or twice a month. You can try it out for just one quarter or like it enough to commit the full school year.

TRAFFIC FLOW MONITORS-Every morning before and after school, we have volunteers that work with the student J.P.O.s (Junior Police Officers) to assure a smooth and safe drop-off and pick-up of your child. Again, you can sign up for as often or little as you like.

NATURE CENTER/SCHOOL GARDEN-Throughout the year, we need help clearing and maintaining both of these areas of our campus.

TUTORING-We have need of folks who'd like to help students that are having difficulty in a specific subject area; times/days for this vary.

AFTERSCHOOL CLUBS-We need parents to help plan, supervise, share talents, be mentors, and help implement these clubs.
