I know it can be sicker shocking for many families to pay the application fees, but students will be in a good position when the school's offer them financial aid packages.

Over the last month, there have been over 900 visits to the Career Center from mostly seniors who have needed assistance with Applications, Federal student Aid, CAL GRANTS, NCAA registration, SAT & ACT Registration, and the Common Application.

Graduating seniors have the opportunity to receive federal or state funded financial support for advanced training for trade or vocational schools or the colleges of their choice.

Once a student is admitted, Financial Aid is offered by the college in the spring when admissions are determined,. It's highly recommended to submit multiple applications with the local school as the default school. When a student is offered admission by more than one school, the student and parents can determine which is the best financially feasible based on their award.
