

Chinese delegation visits Wesley School

A delegation of visitors from China spent the afternoon on Wednesday, Nov. 14 observing and visiting with students at Wesley Elementary School. District 4 Superintendent John Langton and Wesley Principal Katie Purse led the school tour, describing what was being taught as well as the student age and grade level of each classroom.

In the 5th grade classrooms, students greeted the guests by welcoming them in Chinese and by playing a recording of the Chinese national anthem---which the visitors sang along to.

In every classroom, students were given the opportunity to ask questions of their visitors. The most common questions were:

- 1) What is your job? Civil service.
- 2) What sports do you like?

Basketball, football, soccer, badminton, table tennis.

3) What is your favorite food? Many answers, including fish and deep dish pizza.
