

Collierville High School 2018-2019 Registration and Orientation

Frequently Asked Questions for Grades 10-12

All Returning Students:

- 1. Must have completed their online Infosnap registration update.** (For questions contact the school or Student Services at 286-6398)
- 2. Must show proof of residency.**

There is no bus transportation for orientation/registration days.

Do parents need to attend orientation day?

Parents of returning students do not need to attend orientation day unless the parent has not filled out the technology agreement form online. If the technology agreement form has not been filled out by a parent, the student will not receive his or her laptop. The agreement form is on the district's Technology website.

What do I need to send with my child on orientation day?

Students need to bring two proofs of residency and a backpack for the laptop. Please follow dress code for your ID badge picture.

Acceptable Proofs of Residency- Everyone must provide two (2) of the following items showing the parent/guardian's name and address to prove residency: Driver's License, Public/Government Benefits or Assistance, Sales Contract (contingency agreements not accepted), Real Estate Tax Receipt, Mortgage Information, Current MLG&W bill or Turn on Receipt, Municipal Water Bill, Rental or Lease Contract.

Shared Residence Verification:

Shared Residence Proof- Parents/guardians who live with another person must provide a Notarized Shared Residence Affidavit, along with two (2) proofs of residency from the following list: Driver's License, Car Registration, Voter Registration, Payroll Stub, Three (3) Significant Pieces of Mail or Government Assistance Communication. The homeowner must also be present and provide two (2) proofs of residence from the acceptable proof list. For questions contact the schools or Student Services at 286-6398.

Do students have to stay the entire time (8:00 until 11:00am) on their assigned orientation day?

Yes. This will be a busy morning! Students will show proofs, get schedules, go to their homeroom, receive their laptop, get parking/bus info, tour the building – and more! Please follow dress code for your ID badge picture.

My children are in different grade levels. Can they come on the same day instead of different days?

No. Students will be with their grade-level homerooms for part of orientation, so we are only doing orientation with one grade level per day.

What if I can't make it on my assigned day?

Since students will be with their grade-level homerooms for laptop deployment, we are only doing orientation for one grade level per day. If you do not attend orientation day, you will bring your proofs on the first day of school, get your schedule on the first day of school, and will receive your laptop in the following weeks.

My family is new to Collierville Schools. What do I do?

New students enrolling who have not previously enrolled must provide the following: 1) Certified Birth Certificate, 2) TN Department of Health Certificate of Immunization, 3) Social Security Number, 4) Last Report Card if available.

Families who are new to the Collierville Schools school system will register at Collierville Middle School on Wednesdays in July (July 11, July 18, July 25, and August 1) from 8:30am until 11:30am.
