Dear Parents:

Northville Public Schools will accept Section 105 and 105c Schools of Choice applications beginning May 14, 2018 through 4:00 p.m. on June 8, 2018, for five openings in the **International Baccalaureate – Diploma Program** at Northville High School for the 2018 - 2019 school year. *The application process is limited to incoming Juniors who are applying to the full IB Diploma Program.* In order to support the District's goal of excellence and equity for all students, a review of each prospective student applicant's eligibility for the Diploma Program is required using the same criteria applied to prospective resident Diploma Program students.

Final acceptance and selection will be determined based upon the number of openings, eligibility and the number of applications received.

Applications must be received in the Office of Human Resources by **4:00 PM, June 8, 2018**. Students will be notified of placement no later than June 22, 2018.

If the number of approved applications received exceeds the number of spaces specified for Section 105 / 105c students, the District will use a random draw system (see Lottery Procedure) to select the applicants who will be considered for enrollment in identified Section 105 / 105c School of Choice slots. If necessary, the lottery will be held at **8:30 a.m. June 20, 2018** at the Northville Board of Education building (501 W. Main Street; Northville, 48167).
