IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PROMOTION CEREMONY

**Promotion cords will be distributed to every student in attendance.
Promotion certificate will be distributed the last day of school to student.**

ADMISSION & SEATING:

Ceremony begins at 4:30 p.m. Allow time for parking.

PARKING:

Upper parking lot reserved for staff and faculty. Lower parking lot designated for handicapped parking. You may park on the adjacent neighborhood streets.

DRESS CODE:

This is a formal event. Each student will receive a promotion cord.

Ladies: *Please note the weather is often cool, windy and foggy*

Dress or skirt of tasteful length with a modest neckline. No strapless styles. Dress pants and shirt may also be worn. Shawl or sweater recommended for spaghetti straps, backless, halter or one-shoulder styles. Bring dress shoes for rehearsal. Students will be sent home to change if they arrive wearing inappropriate attire.

Gentlemen:

Sport jacket or suit coat optional. Dress shirt with a collar and tie (no polo shirts). Dress slacks or suit pants (no jeans or shorts). Dress shoes (no sneakers)

Students will be sent home to change if they arrive wearing inappropriate attire.

PERSONAL ITEMS:

Students should not bring cameras, purses, bouquets, etc., with them to the assembly area. Cell phones should be silenced and kept out of sight.

PROCEDURE:

Students and guests are expected to contribute to an atmosphere of festive formality with appropriate manners and respect for their fellow students.
