Lake Center Middle School offers a number of extracurricular activities for students. We understand learning occurs both inside and outside the classroom and want to provide additional positive experiences for students. Students can begin their day at the supervised basketball courts shooting hoops or engaging in team contests. They can also stop by Ms. LaRosa's or Ms. Covington's classrooms to play board games, participate in artistic creations, or receive help with homework.

During the day, students can join one of the many clubs or activities we have. If students want to spend some time reading, putting together a puzzle, or doing research or homework, they can stop by our library which is open every day during lunch. Our Associated Student Body also meets regularly during lunch to plan activities and support the students at Lake Center. We also have an anti-bullying club called LAUF, Leopard Always Unite Friends. This is a very popular club – this year over 100 students signed up to join. Another lunchtime organization is our Christian Club. They meet regularly and recently took a fieldtrip to Biola College. They also helped organize "A Week Of Kindness" activities which occurred the last week of November.

Rounding out the day, our after school program Think Together provides a safe place for kids to be after school. They meet every day and are led by their site coordinator, Ms. Herrera. If students need a bit more help with their homework than what is already offered through Think Together, our teacher Ms. Munoz offers homework help and tutoring in room 805 on Mondays and Wednesdays. In addition to this, we also have a science club that meets on select days. You might have seen their work around campus, such as the Lake Center Butterfly Garden near the main office. Overall, we offer many clubs and activities that surpass the regular school day and provide students another layer of involvement while at school.
