Job Location: TSD is located in Knoxville, TN at 2725 Island Home Blvd. Knoxville, TN 37920

Description: The Department of Student Life Cottage Program provides a learning and independent living environment where students and develop to their fullest potential. A Youth Service Worker 1 Night Staff is responsible for ensuring students and cottage safety during overnight hours.

Qualifications:

- High School diploma or GED
- Associates Degree (preferred)
- Valid Tennessee Driver's License
- Child care experience (preferred)

Terms of Employment: Full-Time 10 month position

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Night staff provide supervision of residential students during the night time hours (12:30 AM-8:00 AM) Monday through Friday nights for a total of 37.5 hours a week.
- Night Staff are responsible for observing children's behavior at night
- Making periodic check of students in their bedrooms
- Assisting students who become ill
- Managing emergency situations (fire alarms, inclement warnings).
- Supervisors will leave a list of duties for night staff to complete during their shift which may include laundry, residential cleaning, and other responsibilities as assigned.
- Night staff will be expected to record their activities and observations in the cottage logbooks as well as complete incident reports when necessary by Night Staff Supervisor, Dean, or the Direct of Student Life
