




## Lesson plan for Social Studies - Community

1. Have students get in small groups (4 to 6 per group)
2. Ask students to work together to create a small (8.5 x 11) Sketch note poster, limited words. A sketch note poster should be quick drawings that represent the vocabulary word. <10 minutes to finish
3. Students should share out what a community means to their group
4. Explain to students the expectations for arriving and dismissing to the gym and auditorium for assemblies.
  - a. We are going to dismiss by intercom.
  - b. When walking to the gym we will walk on the right side of the hallways with a voice level of 1.
  - c. When entering the gym or auditorium follow the path provided by the students leaders and then fill from the top to the bottom.
  - d. Watch for the assembly to begin and quiet down, look for the Ram Pride attention signal. Please model what the Ram Pride attention signal is, " One hand up, everyone should hold their hand up and voices should go off." Please make sure that students complete this
5. Explain that we are going to model how we walk to the gym. Please take your students to the gym as a group.
6. Students need to fill out their Ram Pride matrix for the Community
